



How to become an INEXDA member

WHO can become an INEXDA member?

Participation in INEXDA is open to other central banks, national statistical institutes and international organizations.

HOW can my institution become an INEXDA member?

INEXDA members have to sign the MoU¹. Please note that

- Section 4.9 states that sharing of granular data between INEXDA members is not part of this MoU;
- Section 8.3 states that the MoU is not intended to be legally binding.

The following procedure has been established to admit new members:

A representative of the applying institution attends at least one INEXDA meeting in person before the formal application process is initiated.
The applying institution sends an application letter signed by the head of the statistical department of the respective institution (or, in case of national statistical institutes, by the head of the responsible statistical department) to the chair of INEXDA.
All INEXDA members must agree to any application by a new institution.
Signature of the MoU*. Congratulations, you are now a member of INEXDA.
